The EmPower New York Mission:


To deliver high quality energy efficiency services to low-income households with high energy burdens.

- **EmPower households have incomes below 60% of State median**
- **Many of our participants are referred to us by utilities because of an inability to pay utility bills**
- **Low income households sometimes forego medicines, avoid health care treatment, or reduce food consumption in order to make ends meet.**
- **Our goal is to find and provide measures that lower the energy burden.**

Serving Low Income Households

- Ensure a comprehensive review of all potential measures
- Identify the measures that will have the greatest impact for the low income household
- Establish funding levels per household based on consumption
- Provide services at cost-effective pricing
- Provide QA and QC to ensure quality service
